What We Seek

Christ Church is seeking a creative, grounded priest to join a gifted, collegial clergy team in the shared work of preaching, teaching, pastoral care and programmatic leadership. We are a very large congregation of 5,600 engaged parishioners who are committed to our mission to love God, care for each other, and serve the world. This unique role is one of vision, support and empowerment.

In addition to worship leadership and other important clergy roles, our new Associate Rector will be an inclusive visionary who can engage, equip, and empower young adults and families while working with a team of outstanding professionals in Children, Youth and Family Ministry. Unlike similar positions in smaller churches where the priest functions without a staff, in this role, the priest serves as a convener with staff and lay leaders and provides vision and pastoral support to a deeply experienced six-member team with over 50 years of combined experience in ministry. We envision dynamic worship opportunities for all ages, innovative spiritual practices that can occur at home, and unique experiences that are transformative and intergenerational. We envision programs that fully utilize website, mobile applications, and other digital means to meet our families where they are when they are not in church. We hope that what our associate creates here will become a model and an inspiration to the wider Church of what it means to form parents, youth, and children to be 21st century Christians.

This role also includes acting as chaplain to Christ Church Kindergarten (CCK), a preschool with over 50 teachers and 200 students. CCK is a half-day program that emboldens students to develop socially, emotionally, intellectually, physically and spiritually. Children ages 12 months through Kindergarten are encouraged to be active participants in their learning by exploring their abilities, expressing ideas and developing friendships. CCK's mission is to cultivate our children's unique gifts and talents and to inspire lives of learning, serving others and loving God.

Our new Associate Rector will be grounded in worship, engaged in Christian formation and spiritual practices, and committed to diversity, social justice, and civic engagement.

All clergy also participate in pastoral care, weekday liturgies or services, home and hospital visitations, baptisms, weddings, funerals, and other rites of the Church.

STRENGTHENING FAMILIES by imagining and leading parenting classes, family centered and youth centered retreats, youth pilgrimages, curriculum development for all ages, workshops, and meetings.

PARTNERING with Christ Church Kindergarten (CCK), our strong and growing preschool program, by providing support to teachers and staff, actively engaging in grade-level and all-school chapel services, serving on the board, and supporting CCK families.

FORMING AND CELEBRATING YOUNG ADULTS through faith formation, invitations to leadership, and social events to broaden the church experience of this growing population and help them find their place in their Spiritual Home.

CELEBRATING AND HONORING AN INCLUSIVE VISION of what family means in a large, diverse congregation.

DEEPENING RELATIONSHIPS at Christ Church, our Spiritual Home, so that all families feel included and make meaningful connections as a part of this community of charity, justice, and reconciliation.
