

## **Christ Church Nursery Sunday Morning Protocols**

- Registration To limit the number of children in each room and keep the childcare
  area as safe as possible, parents must register their child(ren) each week for the
  worship service or formation offering they are attending. Upon registering, parents
  will receive a confirmation email with details. Registration will close at the 12 noon,
  the day before (Saturday).
- **Pre-Screening** Parents are asked to screen their child(ren) for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 or other illnesses before coming to church.
- Masks Masks are required for all children ages 2 and up. All childcare workers and church staff are required to wear a mask. Adults dropping off and picking up must also be masked while in the lobby.

## Drop-off/Check-in

- Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before the service you are attending to allow sufficient time for rooms to be sanitized and for families at the previous service to leave the building, reducing traffic in hallways.
- Check in will take place in the Nursery lobby. Pre-printed nametags will be provided. You will be asked a series of screening questions at check in time.
- Only one adult may bring their child to the Nursery Lobby. A staff member will find the child's nametag and take him/her to the appropriate classroom.
   Parents may not enter the classrooms.
- **Diapers and Diaper Bags** All children must arrive with a newly changed, clean, dry diaper. All bags must be labeled with your child's name.
- Feedings/Snacks The Nursery will provide individually wrapped snacks, such as Chex cereal.
- Pacifiers All pacifiers must be securely clipped to a child's clothing.
- **Pick-up** Only one adult may pick up their child(ren) from the Nursery lobby. A staff member will bring your child to you.
- Cleaning/Sanitation Rooms will be properly sanitized before the nursery opens each Sunday morning.
- Nursing Mother's Room Access to the Nursing Mother's Room is allowed through the Nursery Lobby. All mothers are asked to remain masked while in the space and sign in on the podium outside the room door, for contact tracing purposes.

If a child becomes ill, a parent will be called to pick up the child immediately. The child will be moved to a separate room and monitored by a designated staff member until a parent arrives.
